**2026 Mass Intentions** - we still have open Masses for the upcoming year. Please call the rectory office if you would like to have a Mass for someone living or deceased.


**Candle and Host Remembrances** - there are openings for both the Candle and Host remembrances for 2026. Please call the rectory office if you would like to reserve a week.

**\*You may opt to stay overnight the evening before for an additional \$125.**


